Over the last few years, Strides has been participating in the 50-30 Challenge aimed at diversifying boards and senior leaders in organizations. While we've achieved the 50-30 Challenge requirements, we do not currently have anyone on the board from 2SLGBTQIA+ communities and believe given the population we serve, this is important.

Strides is a unique organization that provides a broad range of impactful services for infants, children, youth and families including mental health, autism, developmental and community services. Many of our services are focused on east Toronto however, we support some regional and provincial programs as well. In addition, Strides has a system leadership role, as the Lead Agency for infant, child and youth mental health in Toronto. In this role, we work with 23 organizations to plan and deliver accessible, high-quality infant, child and youth mental health services serving Toronto.

In addition, we are seeking a community member to sit on our Quality and Risk Committee. This committee is responsible for monitoring and reporting to the Board on Strides Toronto's risks, quality of service and for championing a culture of continuous improvement, safety and innovation within the Organization.
